



As the Quality Assurance Analyst, you will be responsible for conducting different kind of testing, on various systems, including Cloud based tools. This includes documenting test scripts, executing test scripts, logging, and tracking defects found, and liaising with technical and business personnel to ensure systems meet requirements.

Some of What You'll Do:

- Analyze business and technical specifications of existing and new application systems being developed to understand intended functionality.
- Develop test procedures and scripts that will be executed during testing to ensure optimal application performance that meets functional requirements and quality standards.
- Analyze, evaluate and test new or modified systems to verify programs function according to business requirements and conform to quality standards.
- Communicate areas of concern in a system in terms of performance, ease of use, and logic of business rules. Recommend program improvements or corrections.
- Work through user acceptance testing questions and issues, and facilitate problem resolution;
- Document and track defects and assign to developer for correction. Ensures defects are corrected quickly and re-tests to ensure they are resolved
- Regular contribution to new developments in IT, both technical and process based, as the business continually evolves changes and grows.
